

HOW TO PREPARE YOUR VEHICLE



PREPARING YOUR VEHICLE

All Vehicles Must be in Running Condition, Able to Steer and Stop

- ☐ **For Gas/Diesel Vehicles:** Make sure your vehicle's gas tank is less than 1/4 full
- ☐ **For EVs:** Battery should be charged to 30%–50%
- ☐ Check the 12V battery charge
- ☐ Check tire pressure
- ☐ Check fluid levels
- ☐ Make sure the exterior is clean for inspection

During **Cold Months** (October 1st - April 1st)

- ☐ Check your vehicle's antifreeze and windshield fluid. All vehicles should be prepared to experience temperatures down to -40 degrees fahrenheit.

Secure Personal Effects **Inside the Vehicle**

- ☐ Place items on the back floor boards or back seats; driver's seat and passenger seat must be clear and empty.
- ☐ All windows must have a clear view.
- ☐ All items must be contained within storage bins, boxes, or other sturdy containers.

Secure Personal Effects **In Truck Beds**

- ☐ All items should be lower than the vehicle frame.
- ☐ Secure your items with tie-downs.
- ☐ Your items must be contained within storage bins, boxes, or other sturdy containers.
